What is CES?

The Coordinated Entry System (CES) brings together existing programs into one system connecting homeless adults to the best resources that meet their needs.

CES is designed to eliminate housing waiting lists having 1 survey that connects to real-time housing opportunities.

CES utilizes a standard survey to help service providers better understand a homeless individual's health and housing needs.

Who is Eligible for CES?

Single individuals experiencing homelessness.



How does the CES process work?



Greater Los Angeles
Coordinated Entry System
Survey Packet

Homeless individuals are surveyed using the CES Survey Packet.

Once the survey is complete, the individual is officially entered into the CES housing data-base and receives a contact sheet to follow up with a specific CES Hub.

The homeless individual's Housing Navigator (*i.e. Street Outreach*

Worker, Case Manager, Social Worker, Social Service provider) will contact the surveyed individual if there are any re-resources that they may qualify for.

Benefits of CES

CES ensures every homeless individual is known by name.

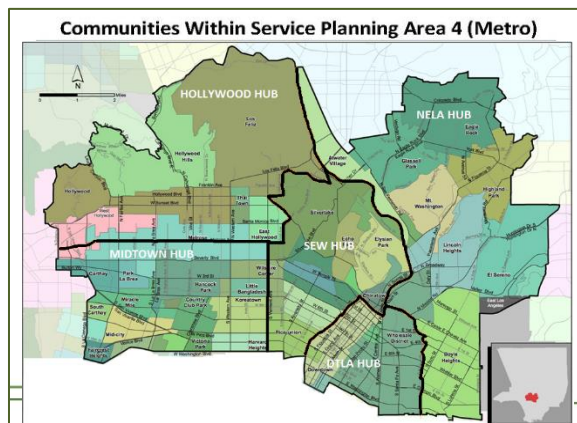
CES connects an individual to supportive services based on their unique needs.

CES matches individual to permanent housing based on the right fit.

How do you get started?

The first step is to complete the CES Survey Packet in order to be placed in the CES Database.

You can visit the closest **CES Access Site** or contact the **CES Coordinator** that services your area and population.

Definitions of Homeless Populations

Family Unit is defined as a unit that consist of at least one (1) parent and at least one (1) *child under the age of 18*.

Transitional Aged Youth (TAY) is defined as a single youth between the ages of 16 – 25 not part of a family unit.

Single Adult is defined as a single adult over the age of 25 and not part of a family unit.
