SHALLOW SUBSIDY PROGRAM

The Salvation Army Shallow Subsidy Program provides rental assistance to individuals or families currently enrolled in a Rapid Re-housing program and need subsequent rental assistance, to maintain their housing while waiting for affordable/senior housing due to rent burden and low income by providing a time limited subsidy of 35% of the monthly rent directly to the landlord or management company.

Additionally, The Shallow Subsidy Program has prioritized slots for clients in a Homeless Prevention program who also need ongoing rental assistance.

The goal of the Shallow Subsidy Program is help program participants achieve housing stability and prevent individuals and families from falling into homelessness.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR SHALLOW SUBSIDY?

- **LA County Leaseholders**
- **Currently active in a Rapid-Rehousing Program or Homeless Prevention Program**
- **Income Under 50% AMI**
- **Monthly income plus Subsidy must be at least equal to monthly rent**
- **Experiencing severe rent burden (60% or more of income towards rent)**
- **Stable as a Tenant- no lease violations**
- **Contributing towards their rent for at least 3 consecutive months**
- **Landlord is willing to work with The Shallow Subsidy Program**
- **Currently not in subsidized housing**



Referrals to the program can only be made by RRH/HP agency

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
